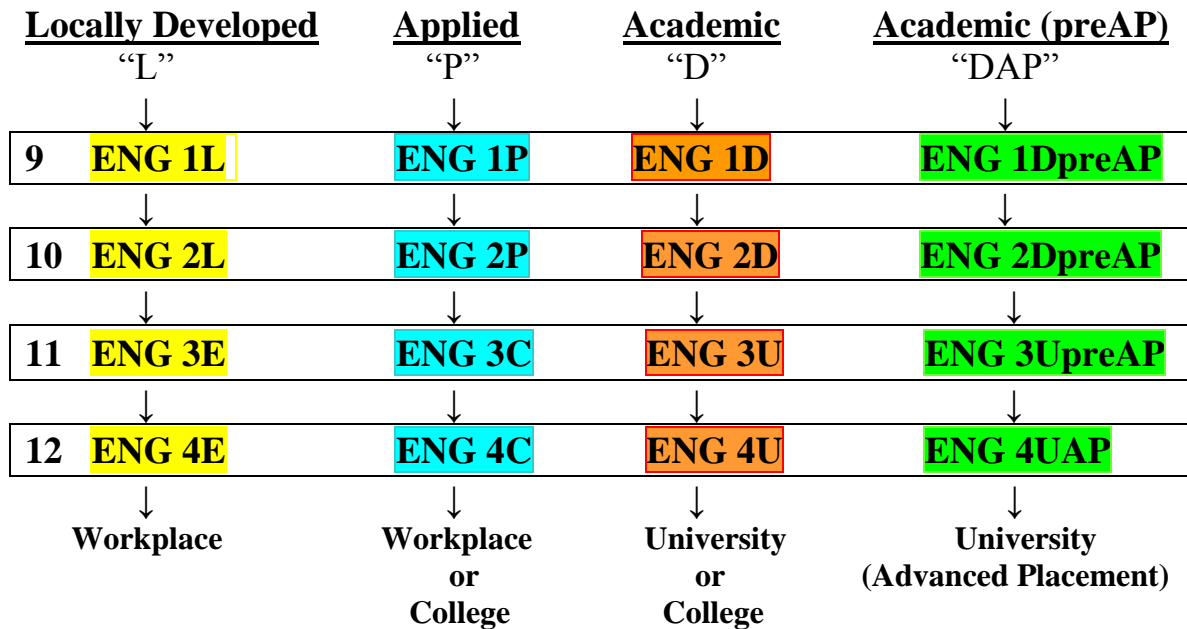


ENGLISH PATHWAYS



Locally Developed: Students taking this pathway often require additional learning supports to improve functional written, oral, and reading comprehension skills. This is a low-enrolment pathway that prepares students for the workplace.

Applied: Students taking this pathway work on application-based English curriculum to improve their comprehension of texts and to help them communicate clearly and effectively. This level prepares students for the world of work or college.

Academic: Students taking this pathway have strong work habits. They will analyse, interpret and create oral, written, and media texts in a variety of forms. This pathway prepares students for studies at the university level.

Academic AP (Advanced Placement): Students choosing this academic pathway have a curiosity about and a strong interest in English studies as well as excellent independent work habits. This course prepares students to write the *English Language and Composition AP* exam in their graduating year. Students with an acceptable score will be granted a university level first-year credit.
